# MAKE A DIFFERENCE IN THE LIVES OF OUR FAMLIES WHO ARE HOUSELESS

Last Monday night FPC hosted our first night of the season for the Emergency Cold Weather Shelter for Families. We will continue to provide a safe and warm place for families experiencing homelessness through the end of April each Monday night.

It takes about ten volunteers each Monday night to provide hospitality for the families. A volunteer brings a warm meal, volunteers interact with the kids (games, crafts, recreation) and visit with the parents and we share the overnight fire watch. In the morning we serve a simple breakfast and support parents as their children go to school and they go to work or other appointments.

Ways to help:

# 1. Prepare an evening meal for 15 people:

Meals needed on October 20 and October 27. (Sign up at the ECWS display in the narthex).

- 2. **Evening Hospitality** (Provide hospitality and security from 5:30p.m. 9:30 p.m.--divided into 3-hour shifts).
  - 3 volunteers needed for October 10, 21 and 28.
- 3. **Overnight Hospitality** (Provide security and hospitality from 9:30 p.m. –7:00 a.m. spend the night and be awake for a 3-hour shift or come for your 3-hour shift).
  - 1 volunteer needed for October 10; 3 volunteers for October 21 and 3 volunteers for October 28.

For evening and overnight hospitality, one needs to fill out an application if a new volunteer.
